



## Let's Go Fly a Kite!

Supplies: 1 piece of patterned paper  
Adhesive and clear tape  
1 bamboo kebab skewer or other stick  
1 20 yard length of string, ribbon, or twine

*Let's make a fun (and pretty!) kite out of paper to beat the summer boredom!*

### Directions:

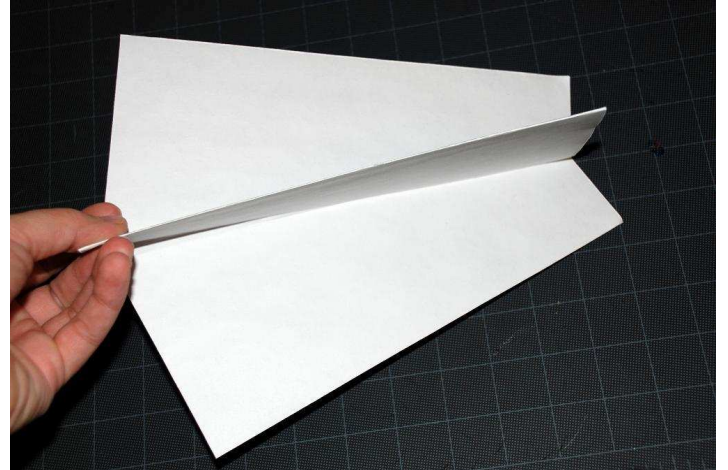
1. Cut your paper to 9.25x12 inches



2. Fold your paper in half lengthwise (9.25x6 inches) and mark a line leading from 1.5 inches from the top left to 1.5 inches from the bottom right.



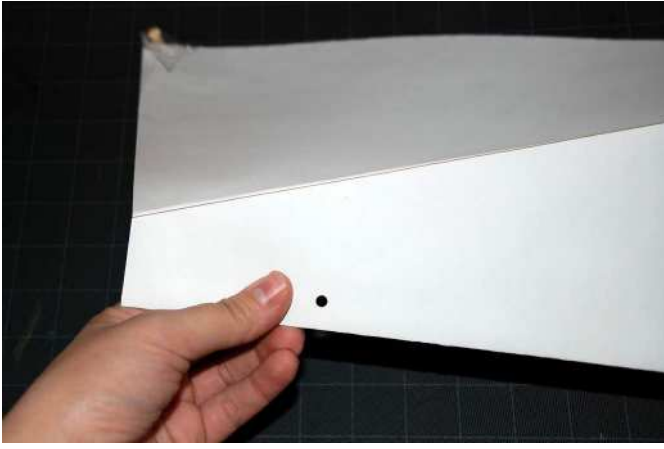
3. Fold the corner on the line. Fold other side down using the fold line as a guide. Using your adhesive, glue together the paper up to the line. Your paper kite should look like this:



4. Tape your stick across the top of your kite



5. Punch a hole in the flap underneath your kite just below where the stick sits on top. Thread your string through this hole and tie a knot.



6. GO FLY YOUR KITE!!! (\*\*of course we don't have a good wind, so this 'flying' was achieved by me running around my yard for about 5 minutes before I finally picked up enough speed and we caught a breeze! LOL) I promise it will fly on a windy day!
