

## Four Fast Card Recipes! Jacquie Veach

Do you make your own cards or would you like to make cards in just minutes? Just like recipes that have only a few ingredients attract me, so do few supplies in scrapbooking and card crafting. I have fun trying to find different ways to use my “extras” too, like the inside of my chipboard letters for centers of flowers. The majority of supplies are from the August Backporch Memories Medley kit, BMP Stamp set or add ons. So, grab your supplies and checkout how quickly you can craft these cards with only a few ingredients to put a smile on a friend or family members face!

### I Love You card

This is a 3X3 card I thought I could drop into my husbands’ briefcase and surprise him when he gets to work.

Ingredients from kit:

- Basic Grey Infused paper
- Grosgrain Ribbon
- Chipboard heart (from inside the swirls)
- Red Cardstock

My Stash

- I Love You stamp
- Red Ink

To make the heart, I punched out the two inside pieces of the swirls chipboard, inked both sides with red ink. I flipped the left inside piece over, tied a ribbon and adhered with tacky glue. I adhered a piece of red cardstock on the back of the card with 1/8” matte to give it a finished look.



### Thinking of You card

Ingredients from kit:

- Basic Grey Infused paper
- Grosgrain ribbon
- French Vanilla Bazzill
- Lillypad Bazzill
- BMP June lower case letter stamps
- BMP August Stamps

My Stash:

- Petaloo's Brown flower
- Scenic Route Chipboard Letter (inside of the letter “b”)



## Thanks So Much Card

Ingredients from kit:

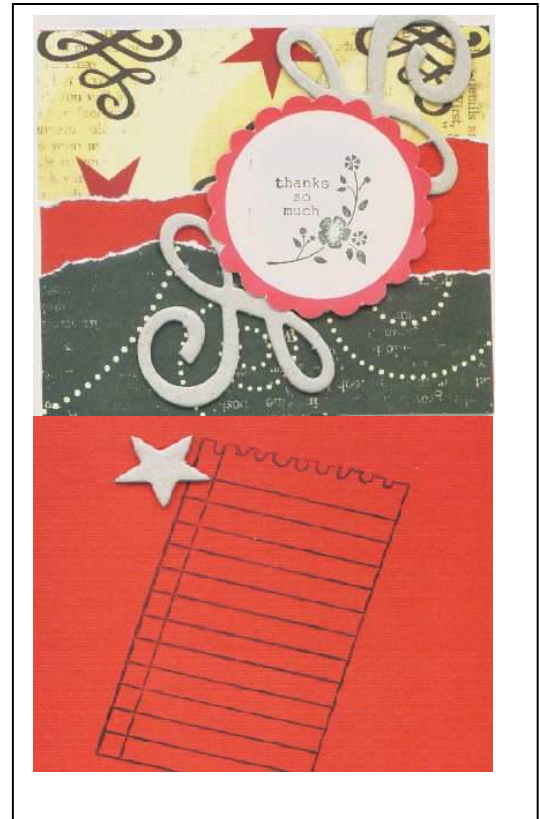
- Rusty Pickle Starry Night Chipboard (YES, I used it naked!)
- Rusty Pickle Mayflower Paper
- Scalloped Note Card (from Medley Addons)
- BMP August stamps (the one that looks like

ripped mini notebook paper)

My Stash:

- Thanks stamp – Stampin’ Up
- Red Cardstock
- Popdots

Tear patterned paper and place on top and bottom of 4.5”X5” card. Stamp greeting on Note Card. Place popdots on back of Note card. Trim off swirls on chipboard and place on card with Note card in center. On inside of card, stamp the ripped notebook paper to write message. Adhere star chipboard.



## Congrats Grad

Ingredients from kit:

- Rusty Pickle Starry Night Chipboard
- Rusty Pickle Mayflower Paper
- French Vanilla Bazzill
- BMP August stamps (the one that looks like

ripped mini notebook paper)

My Stash:

- Scenic Route Rubon letters (congrats)
- Mini letter stickers (grad)
- Red Chalk

Fold 12”X4” cardstock into center to make card. Tear patterned paper and place on left and right sides of card. With q-tip or finger, cover chipboard with red chalk. Then stamp the chipboard with the mini notebook stamp to give it the “stripes”. I placed the chipboard on the card with the star in the center covering both sides of the card. I trimmed the swirl on the right off and adhered with tacky glue. Add greeting and you are complete!
