

# Use Your Scraps

To celebrate the up-and-coming holiday and my Irish roots, I thought it would be fun to create a banner to hang in my home for a cute decoration. I hope it inspires you to create one of your own!



## Supplies:

Solo Kit  
(2) Chipboard Sheets  
Stickles (Patina)  
MM Paints (Meadow & Emerald)  
AC Thickers (Daquiri)  
Hole punch

Various green/white ribbons  
3" shamrock shape  
Green bead necklaces (preferably with little shamrocks attached. I got mine from Target's \$1 section.)

**1.** Trace (4) 6.5x5.5x6.5 triangle shapes onto chipboard. Cut and then trace onto various pattern papers from the Solo kit. Cut out the patterned paper and adhere to the triangle chipboard shapes. Trim edges and ink with the copper Catseye ink. Take the KI lace cardstock that is included in kit and (4) strips. Glue to the triangles WHITE side up. Run your copper ink over it gently.



**2.** Punch holes in the top corners of the triangles along the 5.5" side.

3. Trace shamrock shape onto patterned paper. Cut and then glue onto chipboard. Paint with the Making Memories paints. When completely dry, cut shamrocks from chipboard. Ink all edges.



4. Glue little plastic shamrocks onto the bigger chipboard shamrock shapes if you have them.

5. Punch holes in the opposite corners of the shamrocks and start to tie to the triangles with the green ribbon trim included in kit. Do that for each of the three chipboard shamrocks until all of the banner shapes are attached to one another.

6. Thread green beads through the outside corners of the banner triangles making a slip knot to adhere. On the beads tie strips of various green colors of ribbon.

7. Use the AC Thickers to apply title to the banner – **happy st. patty's day**

8. Apply the Patina Stickles atop of the Thickers to make them pop off the page. Make sure to let Stickles dry completely.
