



Altered Glue Holder

Supplies:

Empty drink mix container

Paper and embellishments from May Medley Kit

Don't you just hate having to wait for your glue to get down to the tip to use it? Are you always losing the lids to your glue, drying out the tip? Do you keep your glue bottle on its side and it leaks on your table?

WELL NO MORE!!! Come with me as we make a holder for our glue bottles that keeps the glue at the tip and does not dry out or make a mess!

Instructions:

1. Grab an empty plastic drink mix container. I used to use Crystal Light containers, but they recently changed their design. No worries! Kool-aid and the Wal-mart brand still have the nice big round ones!



2. Measure the dimensions of your container, mine was 6.25 inches high and about 9 inches around (allowing some overlap when gluing). Decorate your panel.



3. Adhere to your bottle and VOILA! You have your new glue holder.



This container will keep the glue in the tip of your bottle, ready to use. You don't even have to use a lid for your glue (I always lose them). The tip of the glue bottle rests on the bottom of the container and forms a bit of a seal. A little glue may leak out, but it's easy to peel away when you're ready to use it. And it won't make a mess on your table if it leaks, the glue is easy to peel off the bottom of the plastic container if you wish.
